- No lame, blind, injured, sick or substituted animals will be loaded on road transport to registered establishment.
- To the best of my knowledge, livestock sourced for export comply with Australian food safety requirements, including standards for chemical residues or environmental contaminants.
- The animals for export have been resident in Australia since birth.
- Have come from properties free of any known outbreaks or clinical symptoms prior to shipment from the following diseases:
  - Johne's disease, no official reports five (5) years prior to shipment.
  - Bluetongue, Bovine Malignant Catarrhal fever, Mucosal Disease/bovine virus diarrhoea (MD/BVD), Q-Fever, Infectious Bovine Rhinotracheitis / IPV, Haemorrhagic septicaemia, Ephemeral fever, leptospirosis and Enzootic Bovine Leucosis for three (3) years prior to export.
  - Anaplasmosis, Babesiosis, Sporadic bovine encephalomyelitis, Surra, bovine genital campylobacteriosis, trichomoniasis and Anthrax for twelve (12) months prior to export.
  - Theileriasis, Cysticercosis, Intestinal Salmonella infections (Salmonellosis), and Hendra virus for six (6) months prior to export.
  - Trichomyopsis (ringworm), Contagious Ophthalmia (Pink Eye), Actinomycosis and Dermatophilosis
  - All cattle during the thirty (30) days prior to shipment are free from clinical evidence of any diseases.
- The cattle have never been fed with any kind of processed animal proteins. No cattle are within a withholding period or Export Slaughter Interval for antibiotics. The cattle do not contain hormone growth promotant residues at levels harmful to human health, as determined by Codex Alimentarius food safety standards. Cattle showed no clinical signs or abattoir evidence of enzootic bovine leucosis (EBL) during the last two years.
- The cattle have never been fed with any kind of mammalian-derived proteins except milk proteins.
- Female livestock have not been treated with a prostaglandin drug within 14 days of export, and not during the 60-day period before export unless they have been pregnancy tested immediately before prostaglandin treatment and declared to be in the first trimester of pregnancy or not detectably pregnant.
- Transport: All livestock moved to registered establishment will be by transport operators that abide by the current version of ASEL and in direct conjunction with Land Transport Standards. The land transport of livestock for export must meet any relevant animal health and welfare and road transport requirements under state and territory legislation and relevant requirements under national Model Codes of Practice for the Welfare of Animals.
