**Declaration**

- A. Cattle comply with ASEL (Version 3.0) – Standard 1 (Sourcing and on-farm preparation of livestock)
- B. the property has remained free from clinical or visible evidence of Leptospirosis and Leptospirosis has not been officially reported during the 3 years prior to shipment.
- C. the property and cattle residing on the property have been free of any known outbreaks or clinical symptoms for at least 3 years prior to shipment from the following diseases – Mucosal Disease/Bovine Virus Diarrhoea(MD/BVD), 'Q' Fever, intestinal salmonella infections (Salmonellosis), Vibrionic Dysentery, Infectious Bovine Rhinotracheitis (IBR)/Infectious Pustular Vulvo-vaginitis(IPV), Cysticercosis, Genital Campylobacteriosis (Vibriosis), Theileriasis, Sporadic Bovine Encephalomyelitis, Tetanus, Malignant Oedema, Blackleg, pulpy Kidney, Black Disease, Botulism, Bovine Malignant Catarrh. Anaplasmosis, babesiosis, Anthrax, Bluetongue, actinomycosis, malignant catarrhal fever, enzootic bovine leukosis, ephemeral fever, clostridial diseases. bovine pleuropneumonia, bovine brucellosis, foot and mouth disease (without vaccination), haemorrhagic septicaemia, lumpy skin disease, vesicular stomatitis
- D. Australia has been free from Foot and mouth disease, Vesicular stoattis (VS), Rinderpest, contagious bovine pleuropneumonia (CBPP), bovine spongiform encephalopathy (BSE), rift valley fever (RVF), surra, heartwater, screwworm, east coast fever, bovine brucellosis, bovine tuberculosis, lumpy skin disease, haemorrhagic septicaemia, for 5 years
- E. the Property has been free from clinical or visible evidence of Enzootic Bovine Leucosis and Bluetongue for the last 3 years.
- F. The Property has been free from Clinical or Visible evidence or reported cases of Johne's Disease for the last 5 years.
- G. The animals originated from an establishment or farm, where no case of Hendra virus has occurred during the last six (6) months prior to export.
- H. the property is currently free from clinical or visible evidence of any outbreak of the following contagious conditions –, contagious ophthalmia (pink eye), dermatophilosis, trichophytosis (ringworm)
- I. the property is currently free from clinical or visible evidence of any outbreak of Tuberculosis in the past 18 months.
- J. the property is officially classified free of Bovine Brucellosis.
- K. The animals have been kept since birth or for at least 6 months prior to export in Australia where no cases of contagious bovine pleuropneumonia, rinderpest or foot and mouth disease were reported during the one (1) year prior to export.
- L. The animals have never been fed with any kind of processed animal proteins
- M. The animals originated from an establishment or farm, where no case of Hendra Virus has occurred during the last six (6) months prior to Export.
- N. The animals originated from establishment or farm which there were no reports of anaplasmosis, babesiosis genital campylobacteriosis and trichomoniasis during the 24 months prior to the date of export
- O. No cattle are within a withholding period or Export Slaughter Interval for Antibiotics. The cattle do not contain hormone growth promotant residues at levels harmful to human health, as determined by codex Alimentarius food safety standards.
