Scratchings as per ACA rule D5.

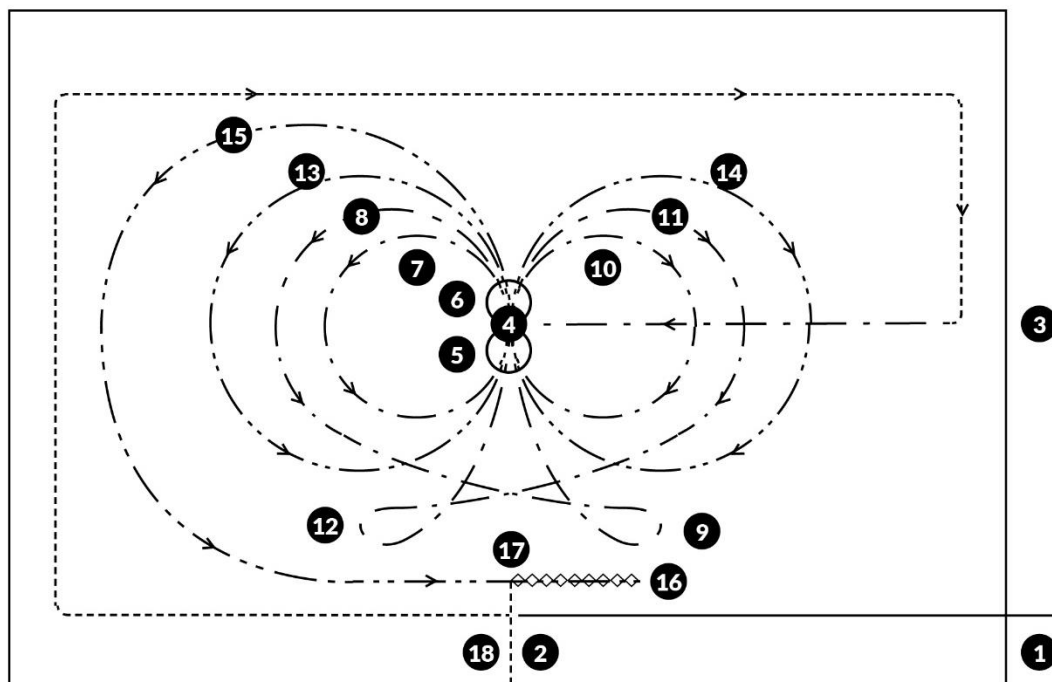
Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary within one (1) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$100 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$100 is forfeited.

The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse with exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement Campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating e.g. if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft

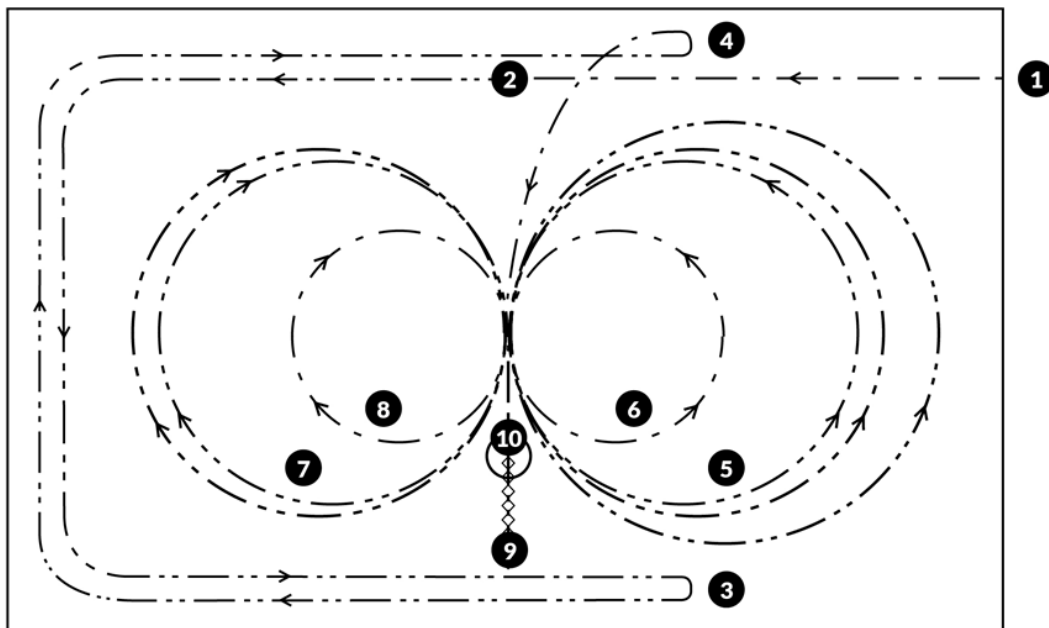
Working Pattern - Preliminary Round (Classic, Encouragement & Juvenile)

0	Crack whip and commence work.
1	Enter working arena on a loose rein at a walk.
2	Pick up a working trot and trot around the working area to 3.
3	Pick up a working canter and canter a straight line on off lead.Halt
4	
5	360° spin to left.
6	1¼ spin to right.
7	Canter a small slow circle to left on near lead.
8	Canter large faster circle to left. Do not close but continue to 9.
9	Stop and without hesitation do a right roll back. Continue back to centre line at a canter on off lead.
10	Canter a small slow circle to right.
11	Canter a larger faster circle to the right, do not close but continue on to 12.
12	Stop, and without hesitation do a left roll back. Continue back to centre line at a canter on near lead.
13	
14	Gallop a fast figure or eight with 2 flying changes.
15	Continue at a gallop around to 16.
16	Stop and settle horse.
17	Back horse over tracks.
18	Ride to judge for inspection on a loose rein. Halt.
19	Overall horsemanship (including the demonstration of continuity between sections and an impression of free flowing movements.

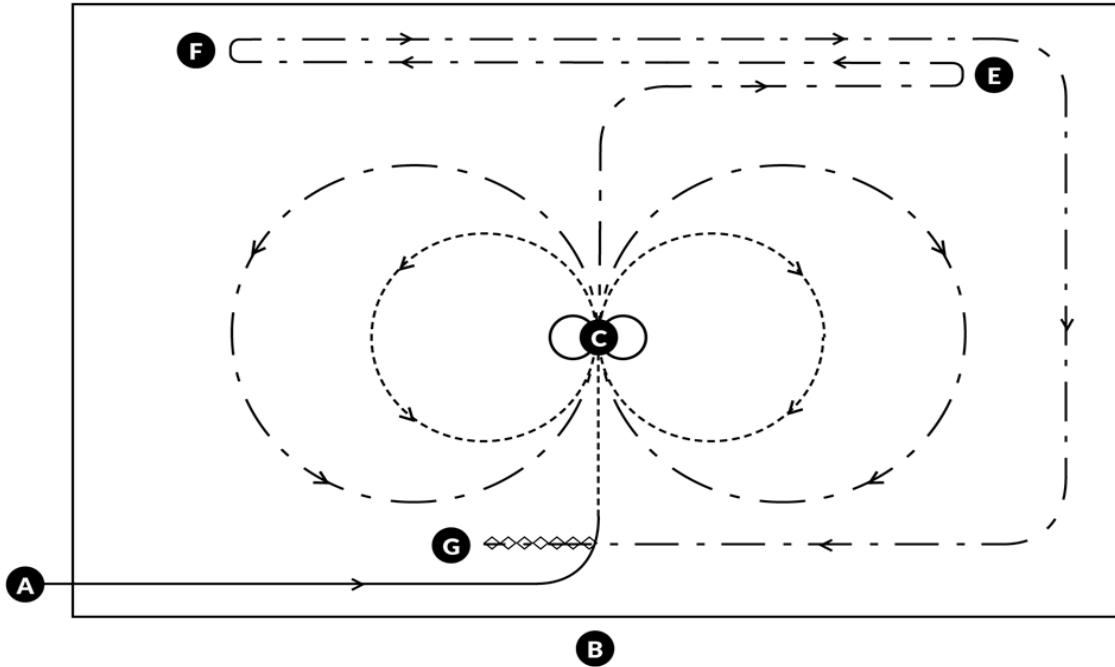
Working Pattern - Final Round (Classic, Encouragement & Open)

1	Enter arena at a working canter.
2	At 2 gallop around the working area to 3 on correct lead.
3	Stop and without hesitation to a right rollback. Continue at a gallop on to 4 on correct lead.
4	Stop and without hesitation do a left rollback. Proceed to the centre of the work area at a canter on correct lead.
5	Gallop two large, fast circles to the left on correct lead.
6	At the centre of the work area, canter a small slow circle to the left on correct lead. Do a flying change at the centre.
7	Gallop two large, fast circles to the right on correct lead.
8	At the centre of the working area canter a small slow circle to the right on the correct lead. Do a flying change at the centre. Gallop a large circle to the left on correct lead. Go through the centre to 9.
9	At 9, stop. Back over tracks at least 3 metres.
10	Do two 360° spins to the right. Do two 360° spins to the left.
11	Leave the work area at a walk. Demonstrate the horses acceptance of the whip at the walk.

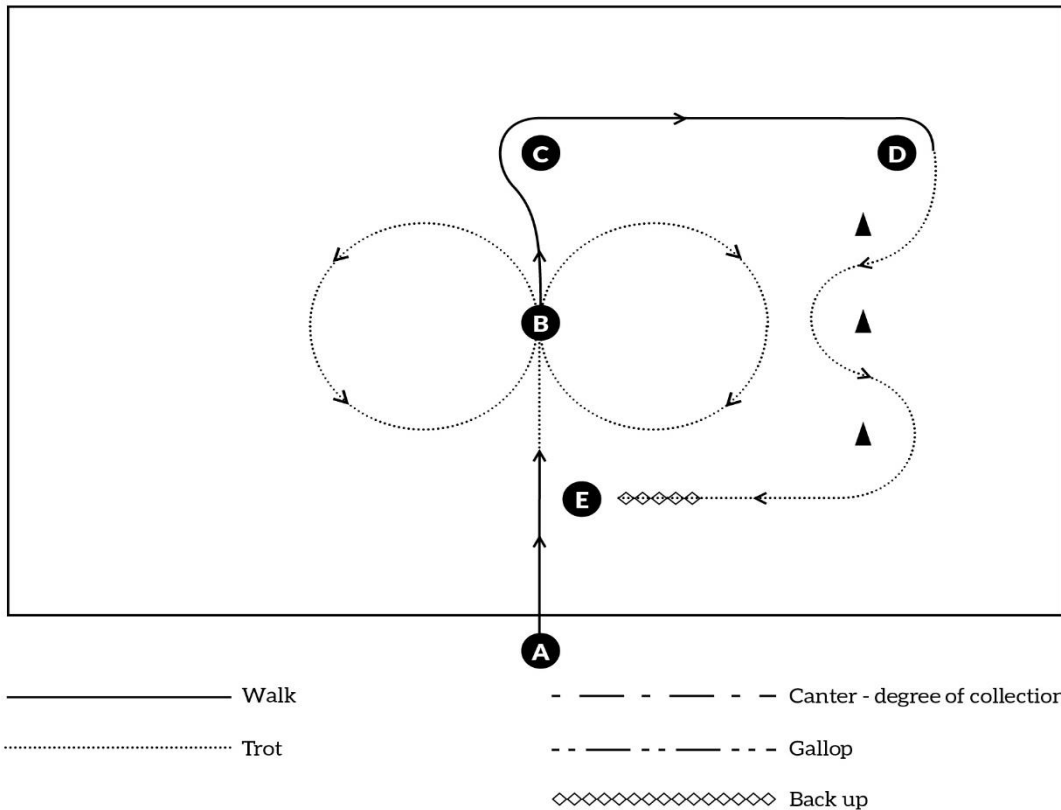
Junior Challenge Pattern

1	Salute Judge at A
2	Walk to B
3	Rising trot to C (center). Stop.
4	360° spin to the right.
5	360° spin to the left.
6	Trot a medium circle to the right.
7	Trot a medium circle to the left.
8	At C canter a large circle to the right on the right lead.
9	At C do a simple change and canter a large circle to the left on the left lead.
10	At C do a simple change and canter to E on the right lead. Stop.
11	Do a rollback to the left and canter to F on the left lead. Stop.
12	Do a rollback to the right and canter on the right lead all the way to G and stop.
13	Back your horse until you are in line with the judge. Stop.
14	Turn and face the judge, salute. Leave arena on a loose rein.

Mini Challenge Pattern

| 1 | At A, salute Judge and walk to B. Stop. |
| 2 | Trot a large circle to the right. |
| 3 | At B, trot a large circle to the left. Stop at B. |
| 4 | Walk to C (Drum). Stop and pick up billy can and walk to D (Drum). |
| 5 | Place billy can on D (Drum). |
| 6 | Trot through the pegs as on the diagram all the way to E (Judge). |
| 7 | Stop horse and back up two steps. |
| 8 | Salute the Judge. |
