representative of the above mentioned property, declare to the best of my knowledge, the animals prepared and handled for export have met with any relevant road transport requirement s under state or territory legislation and relevant requirements under the national Model Codes of Practice for the Welfare of Animals. ASEL Standard 2.6 (Standard for Land Transport of Livestock for Export and OIE (World Organization for Animal Health) Chapter 7.3 (Transport of Animals by Land). Please sign below if you conform to these requirements.

- A travel plan has completed for all journeys of more than 8 hours duration and interstate journeys greater than 2 hours. (ASEL S.2.3)
- Livestock have been mustered and handled to prepare for land transportation to maintain health and fitness for travel. Feed and water curfews are to be observed. (ASEL 2.4; 2.8; 2.9; Appendix 2.3)
- Livestock were inspected prior to loading and any animal showing signs consistent with the rejection criteria in Standard S1.7 of Standard 1 or any other condition that may cause animals health to decline were not loaded. (ASEL S.2.11). The owners and managers of the livestock are responsible for the general health, overall welfare and fitness of the animals for the journey (OIE A.7.33)
- Ensure vehicles are of appropriate design, clean and in maintained in good working order, for the type of livestock transported. Transport operators are responsible for this requirement and must maintain a journey log book.
- Livestock drafted and loaded for transport by land were separated by class, species and size. Livestock with horns over 12cm separated from other livestock. (ASEL 2.10) Livestock not to be loaded until a travel plan is completed (ASEL 2.12)
- Livestock were loaded in a manner that prevents injury and minimises stress including loading densities and penning arrangements. The person responsible for the land transport vehicle must be responsible for the livestock (ALES S2.13-S2.16).
- Working dogs are not transported in the same pens as livestock. Livestock will be unloaded and rested as specified in Appendix 2.1 and in accordance with state/territory legislation. At unloading the livestock will become the responsibility of the management personal of the registered premises. Distressed or injured livestock must be given immediate assistance. Humane euthanasia to be carried out if necessary (ASEL S2.17 - 2.20).
- Livestock will be unloaded into registered premises by competent stock handlers in a manner that prevents injury and minimizes stress (ASEL 2.21 – 2.24)
