- 2. The Biosecurity Manual (Cattle Ticks) provides guidance on the intervals from the last preliminary treatment within which the stock can be presented to an accredited certifier:
- Acaricides by spraying or plunge dipping a minimum period of four (4) days and a maximum of seven (7) days; or
- Endectocides [Macrocyclic lactones that have a full claim for the control of cattle ticks] by injection or pour on a minimum period of six (6) days and a maximum of nine (9) days.
