There was a small increase in supply to 208 head at the Toowoomba cattle sale. Young cattle were in the largest numbers along with a few grown steers and bullocks, and the cow section was dominated by dairy classes. Prices continued to maintain the recent high levels. The regular trade and feeder buyers were in attendance and operating, plus a large number of restockers were again active in the market and had the greatest influence on a number of classes.

Yearling steers under 200kg to restockers made to 698c to average 638c/kg. Yearling steers under 280kg averaged 564c and made to 610c/kg. Yearling steers to feed for the domestic market averaged from 556c to 566c and sold to a top of 588c/kg. Heavy weight yearling steers to feed sold to 458c, averaging 450c/kg. Light weight yearling heifers averaged 488c and made to 568c/kg. Yearling heifers to feed averaged from 492c to 496c and sold to a top of 508c/kg. Heavy weight yearling heifers to feed made to 486c to average 433c/kg.

A handful of bullocks to export processors made to a top of 410c/kg. The vast majority of the dairy cows sold to restockers at an average of 230c with sales to 250c/kg. The occasional heavy weight cow made to 290c/kg. Heavy weight bulls sold to 327c/kg.
