The supply of stock reduced by 135 head to 205 at the Toowoomba cattle sale. Export buyer attendance was similar to the previous week with the regular feed and trade buyers in attendance and operating, plus a large line up of restockers. Young light weight cattle continued to be in demand from restockers and feeder operators were also very active in the market. The small selection of cows experienced strong competition for the quality penned and the handful of bullocks sold to strong demand.

A short supply of light weight yearling steers returning to the paddock averaged 511c and made a top of 552c/kg. Yearling steers to feed for the domestic market made to a top of 526c and averaged from 446c to 506c/kg. Yearling steers under 330kg sold to restockers at an average of 521c, making a top of 528c/kg. Heavy weight yearling steers to feed made a top of 444c, to average 423c/kg. Yearling heifers under 200kg made to an isolated 556c, while the under 280kg range averaged 511c and made to 538c/kg. Yearling heifers to feed for the domestic market averaged from 441c to 471c with the occasional sale making 500c/kg. Heavy weight yearling heifers to feed made to a top of 436c/kg.

Bullocks to export processors over 750kg made to a top of 374c/kg. Medium weight score 2 cows averaged 267c with the score 4 cows averaging 294c/kg. Good heavy weight cows averaged 295c and made to a top of 300c/kg.
